*****Winter Parking on Streets*****

Please be advised that from November 1st, 2016 to April 30th, 2017, residents are asked not to park on the streets from 12:00 midnight to 8:30 a.m. All vehicles are to be parked inside the Township pole lines and the owner's property. Should we be required to do plowing these hours, we will have vehicles towed away at the owner's expense. The Township also wishes to advise residents that during daytime hours when the Works Department is snow plowing the streets, any vehicle parked on the street interfering with the snow plowing, and the flow of traffic, will also be towed at the owner's expense. We would greatly appreciate your cooperation by not parking on the street when there is a snow storm.

*****Winter Snow Removal*****

The Township would like to remind all residents that it is an offence to put snow from your property onto town streets. Anyone caught putting snow on the streets will be charged with littering. It is suggested that you contact the local snow removal contractors to have your snow hauled away to avoid any obstructed view on corners and driveways. The Township of Larder Lake would appreciate everyone's cooperation on this matter.

TAKE NOTICE THAT pursuant to Sections 17 and 26 of the *Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990*, as amended, the Corporation of the Township of Larder Lake will hold a public meeting regarding the development of a 5-Year Update to the Official Plan. The Public Meeting will be held as follows:

TIME 7:00 p.m.

LOCATION Council Chambers, Municipal Complex, 69 Fourth Street, Larder Lake, Ontario

THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT of the Official Plan is to set the course of growth and development of the Town over the next 20 years and to ensure that it addresses provincial policy and plans, and areas of concern or interest.

The purpose of the public meeting is to provide an opportunity for the public to review and comment on the draft update to the Official Plan. Copies of the Official Plan are available online for review, or a copy can be requested at the Municipal Complex.

ANY PERSON, AGENCY OR ASSOCIATION may attend the public meeting and/or make written or verbal representation either in support of or in opposition to the Town's new Official Plan. If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at an open house/public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Larder Lake before the Official Plan is passed, the person or public body may not be entitled to appeal the decision of the Township of Larder Lake to the Ontario Municipal Board. Should you be unable to attend and wish to provide comments, please contact the Municipal Complex, during office hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday to Friday), at 705-643-2158.
