### Re: Sewer Rates

As per the motion passed at the Regular Council Meeting of March 28, 2017, please be advised that the sewer rates will increase by \$1.75 per month effective May 1, 2017. There will also be an additional increase of \$1.66 effective May 1, 2018.

It is important to understand that the operation of the sewer facility must be self-supporting and that all costs, operating and capital requirements are funded through the users of these facilities.

During this period, customers may experience periods of lower pressure and discolored water. If you experience discolored water, please allow your water to run until clear.

2017 Dog & Cat Tags are available at the Township Office at a cost of \$20.00 per tag. The deadline for buying dog & cat tags is February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017 after this date the tags will cost \$30.00. Pet owners should give this matter their immediate attention to avoid a fine and an increasing tag fee.

**\*\*\*\*\*Spring Clean Up Week May 23<sup>rd</sup> – May 30<sup>th</sup> 2017\*\*\*\*\***

Spring Cleanup Week will be held May 23<sup>rd</sup> to the 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017. All Waste must be place at curb not later than **8:00 a.m. Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017.**

Council would like to take this time to remind all residents of the Clean and Clear By-Law #: 1217-08 being a by-law to provide for Maintaining Land in a Clean and Clear Condition. Please take this notice as an opportunity to make arrangements to dispose of these items in a proper manner. Please feel free to view a copy of the By-Law on the Township website @ [www.larderlake.ca](http://www.larderlake.ca) as well as at the Municipal Complex. Please help keep our Community Clean!

- Brush should be cut in 36 inch length and tied into bundles.
- Steel and wood products should be placed into different piles so we can separate this waste accordingly for landfill purpose.
- Yard waste should be put into containers or garbage bags no more than 50 pounds each.
- **NO CONSTRUCTION WASTE** will be picked up; this includes material such as boards, roofing materials, drywall etc.

For all residents of Larder Lake **except contractors**, tipping fees will be waived for materials to be taken to the landfill during the week of the Annual Spring Cleanup Week May 23<sup>rd</sup> – May 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Regular tipping fees will be levied to all contractors for the disposal of construction materials at the landfill during these times.

**Please note:** that the Landfill **will not** accept refrigerators and freezers unless they have been cleared and tagged. The Landfill attendant will be checking for these tags and if not affixed to the appliance he will not allow the appliance to be disposed of at the landfill site.

**Fire Permits**

All residents are reminded that By-Law # 1435-12 requires **all residents wishing to burn wood or by-products of wood only are to obtain a fire permit from the Larder Lake Fire Department.** Residents are also reminded that in the event of a fire ban that is proclaimed by the Ministry of Natural Resources, all fire permits are cancelled. You must obtain a new permit every year.

We would also like to remind all residences you are not allowed to burn prohibited substances such as kitchen garbage, construction materials and materials containing rubber, plastics, tar or any which emit a noxious or poisonous substance or pollutant. All residents who wish to have a campfire in their back yards should do so using an approved Outside Fire Pit or Outside Fireplace and they must be inspected by the Larder Lake Fire Department.
