Ontario's Carbon Monoxide Awareness Week runs from November 1-7, 2017.

Clocks will fall back one hour at 2:00 a.m. on November 5, 2017 and the Larder Lake Fire Department is recommending that residents install new batteries in their smoke and carbon monoxide alarms when they change their clocks.



You must install a **carbon monoxide alarm** adjacent to all sleeping areas if your home has a fuel-burning appliance, a fireplace or an attached garage.

*****Larder Lake Walleye Report for 2017*****

A total of 610,000 Walleye eggs were collected during the spring of 2017 spawning period. 350,000 eggs were hatched (Fry). 240,000 Fry were released back into Larder Lake. 110,000 of the Fry were placed into the two rearing ponds to be raised into the fingerling stage (about one month). The resulting 15,000 fingerlings were then released back into Larder Lake at four different locations.

Thanks to the Stewardship Rangers from the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry who assisted in the stocking of the fingerlings raised in the rearing ponds.

A special thanks to the volunteers who came out to help in the Walleye program this past season.

Thank-you to Rita and Steve Harvey (Organizers of the annual Trevor King Memorial Slo Pitch Tournament) for their donation of \$1,170.00 which was raised at the tournament and donated to the Larder Lake Walleye project.

Thank-you to Jim Stevens and Miriami Niemi for running the BBQ and selling beverages to raise additional funds for the Walleye project.

Thank-you to Sue Sheldon-Canon for selling 50/50 tickets with proceeds going to the Larder Lake Walleye project.
