*****Winter Landfill Hours*****



Effective **October 1, 2017 – April 30, 2018**

Thursday: 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
Saturday: 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Public Works will only pick up household garbage. All non-household garbage must be delivered to the landfill site. If after 24 hours the Public Works has to pick up non-household garbage, you will be invoiced to cover the cost. **Only during clean-up week will the Public Works deliver non-household garbage to the landfill site.**

The Larder Lake Public Works Department would like to inform the general public of the upcoming water main flushing operations. The operations will take place **Monday, October 2nd, 2017, to Friday, October 6th, 2017 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.**

During this period, customers may experience periods of lower pressure and discolored water. If you experience discolored water, please allow your water to run until clear.

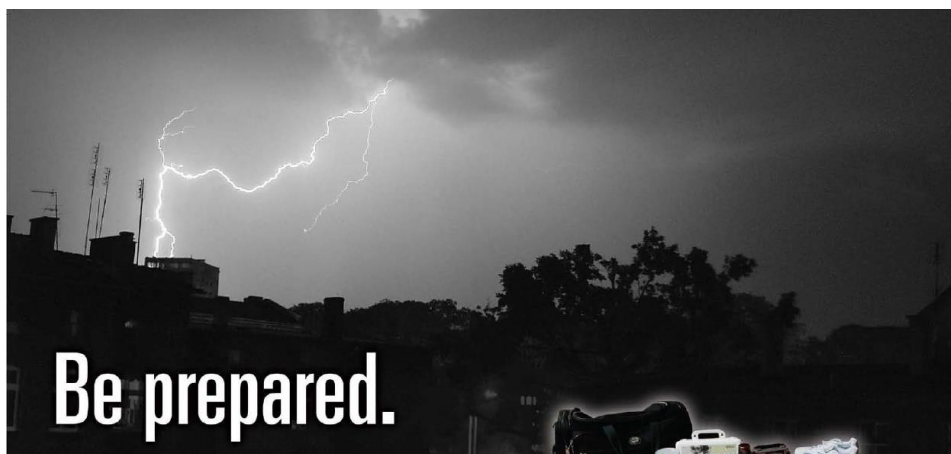
*******Larder Lake Fire Department*******

The Larder Lake Fire Department will be checking houses for fire and carbon monoxide detectors Wednesday October 11th, 2017 during Fire Prevention Week between the hours of 6:30-8:00 p.m. Please make sure to change the batteries in your alarms. The Fire Department reminds everyone that the Ontario Fire Code requires smoke alarms to be installed on every story of your home and outside all sleeping areas. Please note that existing residential occupancies that contain at least one fuel-burning appliance (e.g., gas water heater or gas furnace), fireplace or an attached garage, require the installation of a CO alarm.



You must install a **carbon monoxide alarm** adjacent to all sleeping areas if your home has fuel-burning appliance, a fireplace or an attached garage.
